She was a devoted mother and grandmother who was adored by her children and grandchildren. In every family there is a quiet dynamic, guiding force, and Sarah was ours. On Sunday, March 4th, Sarah quietly passed away while anxiously awaiting an appointment for a specific breast screening MRI procedure.

As each day went by, the anxiety of waiting weighed heavily on Sarah causing extreme mental anguish and additional strain. I cannot help but believe that Sarah's quality of life was severely impacted by this wait. We have since learned that although St. Catharines does have an MRI, it does not have the coil required to do the specific breast screening test that Sarah and others required due to their diagnosis.

Sarah was always helping others, and trying to ease their stress, so to honour her memory and reduce wait times, my family and I have established a very specific memorial fund in Sarah's name to raise funds to purchase Niagara's first Breast Coil that will enhance our existing MRI equipment.

Although we were unable to save my Sarah's life, we believe that your help can truly make a difference. Sarah would be so honoured to know that so many people gave of their heart to this important cause, in her memory.
